East End Citizens Advice Bureaux	Providing fuel vouchers and holistic advice to support with the cost of living crisis.	5,000

Treasured Moments	Providing young people with a warm meal at times when they have no access at all to nutritious foods and may otherwise go hungry.	5,000
Turkish Cypriot Cultural Association	Distribution of food parcels and necessity items.	5,000
Turning Corners	Provision of baby formula to mothers with severe postnatal depression (PND) or psychosis, as well as new parents with pre-existing mental illness who are prescribed medications that may not be suitable for breastfeeding.	5,000
Twilight Kindness	Distribution of credit vouchers for pre-paid meters, oyster- card credit for public transport and goody bags filled with food and personal care items.	5,000
